We accept items that are clean and in good working order.

Items must be suitable for re-sale: clean, odour-free and not broken.

WE ACCEPT:

- Current men's, women's and children's clothing
- Current Jewelry, accessories and shoes
- Crystal, china, collectibles
- Antiques, vintage items, dishes
- Home décor items
- Artwork, pictures, frames
- New boxed electrical items
- Small pieces of furniture
- Books (no more than 10 years old)
- CDs and DVDs

SORRY, BUT WE CANNOT ACCEPT:

- Items that are broken, faded, torn, stained, worn, have pet hair, tobacco or mildew odours
- Yard Sale leftovers, or Dollar store items
- Pajamas, underwear: no intimate-wear even if new
- Beds & mattresses
- Used towels, sheets or blankets
- Pillows and cushions – new or used
- Upholstered items or furniture
- Children's equipment, plush toys
- Sports equipment
- Electrical items (unless new & in box), microwaves, computers
- Encyclopaedias, text books or magazines

Donor Income Tax Receipt Policy

Hospice Greater Moncton is pleased to provide an annual income tax receipt to our generous donors for the value of their items as sold in The Hospice Shoppe.

Items that are not sold in The Hospice Shoppe do NOT receive a tax-receipt.

Each donor is issued a Donor Id# that is attached to the donated items. When it sells, the sale is registered with the Id#. Tax receipts are issued to the Donor Id# at the beginning of each year for items that sell in the Shoppe, for total over \$20.
